

Setting program to No Longer Accepting Applications in ERAS Account Maintenance (EAM)

This job aid will walk you through the process for updating your program participation status to “No Longer Accepting Applications”. After doing so, applicants who have already applied can continue to send document updates, but this will prevent new applicants from being able to apply to your program.

1. Navigate to [ERAS Account Maintenance \(EAM\)](#) and click Sign into EAM with AAMC Account.
