



EDITOR, JOURNAL OF MARITAL AND FAMILY THERAPY

The Board of Directors of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) is currently soliciting applications for Editor of the *Journal of Marital and Family Therapy* (JMFT). The goal of the JMFT is to ensure the continued development of the science, theory, and practice of marriage and family therapy.

The position would start in October 2023 and include a three-month orientation and training. Full editor duties would commence January 2024.

The required application materials include a vitae detailing the candidate's editorial experience, including relevant skills and background; a written statement of intent to serve, if chosen; a written statement concerning how the candidate views the editorship role, including future directions of the JMFT; a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion statement; descriptions of university/employer support for the editorship; and names and contact information for three references who can speak to the quality of their work and their qualifications for the editorship role.

The Search Committee may solicit additional information such as: samples of the candidate's recent published writing, previous editorial work, or a description of resources or support services needed to successfully fulfill the editorship role.

Before submitting materials, all potential applicants should review, and be very familiar with, the JMFT Strategic Plan. That plan, as well as a detailed job description, and additional information concerning the JMFT editorship can be found at <http://networks.aamft.org/editorsearch/home>.
