



- CMS <u>announced</u> that Medicare beneficiaries can receive coverage of monoclonal antibodies to treat coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) with no cost-sharing during the public health emergency (PHE).
- CMS <u>released</u> a toolkit to accelerate state efforts to rebalance long-term care systems and enhance home and community-based services for eligible Medicaid beneficiaries.
- CMS <u>launched</u> a new online platform the Nursing Home
 Resource Center to serve as a centralized hub bringing
 together the latest information, guidance and data on
 nursing homes that is important to facilities, frontline
 providers, residents and their families, especially as the fight
 against coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) continues.
- CMS <u>announced</u> its commitment to ensure all Americans, including the nation's seniors, have access to the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccine at no cost when it becomes available.
- CMS <u>released</u> data showing that 21% of Medicare beneficiaries report forgoing non-coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) care due to the pandemic, and nearly all - 98% of beneficiaries have taken preventative measures to keep themselves safe from the virus.
- CMS continues to hold calls with clinicians, hospitals, other facilities, and states in an effort to keep stakeholders updated on COVID-19 efforts. Find more general information on COVID-19.




Department for Health and Human Services (HHS)

- HHS <u>published a press release</u> titled "KidneyX COVID-19 Kidney Care Challenge Seeks Replicable Frontline Solutions."
- HHS <u>announced</u> that it is preparing to provide ancillary supply kits to help healthcare workers who will be administering COVID-19 vaccines.
- HHS <u>announced</u> it distributed incentive payments to nursing homes curbing COVID-19 deaths and infections.
- HHS and DoD <u>announced</u> an agreement with Eli Lilly and Company to purchase the first doses of the company's COVID-19 investigational antibody therapeutic bamlanivimab, also known as LY-CoV555.
- HHS <u>published a press release</u> titled "HHS Delivers 125 Million Masks to Support Safe School Reopening."
- HHS <u>announced additional guidance</u> under the Public Readiness and Emergency Preparedness Act (PREP Act) authorizing qualified pharmacy technicians and stateauthorized pharmacy interns to administer childhood vaccines, COVID-19 vaccines when made available, and COVID-19 tests, all subject to several requirements.
- HHS and DoD <u>announced</u> agreements with CVS and Walgreens to provide and administer COVID-19 vaccines to residents of long-term care facilities (LTCF) nationwide with no out-of-pocket costs.
- HHS <u>announced</u> that it will provide a saliva test at a surge testing site in Waco, TX.
