President of the American Association of Nurse Practitioners (AANP), Dr. Kapu is an acute care nurse practitioner at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, Associate Dean for Clinical and Community Partnerships, and Professor at Vanderbilt University School of Nursing. This month, Dr. Kapu <u>was interviewed in the article</u> "Creating Healthy Work Environments for NPs During the COVID-19 Pandemic" by *Clinical Advisor*. As the Delta COVID-19 variant remains dominant, and with the Omicron variant now on the radar, Dr.
