Featured Fellow

Academy Living Legend, retired **Brigadier General Clara Adams-Ender**, MSN, CNAA, RN, FAAN, LLAAN, has been serving on the frontlines to vaccinate her community of Manassas, Virginia to combat COVID-19. This year marks 60 years in nursing practice for BG Adams-Enders, including serving as the 18th Chief of the Army Nurse Air Corps, and she is continuing to make an extraordinary impact. Her volunteer work with the Medical Reserve Corps of Virginia was highlighted in a recent <u>Yes! Weekly</u> article, which included a <u>video interview</u> produced by the U.S. Department of Defense, where she discusses why she decided to get vaccinated and why she's helping others get vaccinated.



"I'm out here right now giving the vaccine and doing my work as a nurse because I heard that the nation needed to be vaccinated." BG Adams-Ender said "I chose to give the vaccine because I have taken many, many vaccines over my course of living that had to do with diseases and communicable diseases that were causing us problems at the time and so I just considered that this was another one that we had to deal with." Before retiring after 34 years in the Army, she put in motion many strategies to assist with recruiting and retaining military nurses. BG Adams-Ender continues to leverage her expertise through similar efforts today based largely on a tailored outreach providing information, education, and logistical support in her community to stop the spread of COVID-19.




