
Fellow Highlights

Meghani, PhD, MBE, RN, FAAN, Professor of Nursing & Term Chair of Palliative Care and Associate Director of the NewCourtland Center for Transitions and Health are defining the role of palliative care nurses during COVID-19. In addition to the editorial above, the pair also authored "Recommendations to Leverage the Palliative Nursing Role During COVID-19 and Future Public Health Crises" in *Journal of Hospice and Palliative Nursing*. Their articles identify the critical role of the palliative nurse in the midst of COVID-19 and the increasing burden placed on these nurses during times of crises. Their research will inform decisions on the response to COVID-19 and future public health emergencies.



Share of active Epic patients who received a COVID-19 test, per 10,000:





Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)

 CMS released preliminary Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) data revealing that, during the

- coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency (PHE), rates for vaccinations, primary, and preventive services among children in Medicaid and CHIP have steeply declined.
- CMS announced new federal funding for 33 States to support transitioning individuals from nursing homes to the community.
- CMS issued revised guidance providing detailed recommendations on ways nursing homes can safely facilitate visitation during the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic.
- CMS announced the final report from the independent Coronavirus Commission for Safety and Quality in Nursing Homes (Commission), which was facilitated by MITRE.
- CMS announced its 2020-2021 flu season campaign with new resources to encourage people with Medicare or other CMS health care programs to get their flu shot.
- CMS continues to hold calls with clinicians, hospitals, other facilities, and states in an effort to keep stakeholders updated on COVID-19 efforts. Find more general information COVID-19.
