The school is ranked among the top 50 in research funding, and dedicated to advancing evidence-based clinical practice and the discipline of Nursing through scholarly research, education, and practice.

Earlier this year, the University of California, Irvine received the largest gift in its history, a \$200 million donation from Susan and Henry Samueli to name the first of its kind Susan and Henry Samueli College of Health Sciences, which will position UCI as a new leader in population health, patient care, education and research.
