The Dean will be a builder and a thought leader at the vanguard of health care integration.

The Founding Director of the School of Nursing will work closely with the Dean to build both graduate and undergraduate nursing programs that reflect the Catholic tradition of care and contribute to the mission of the College. The Director will create a vision and plan that will position the University of St. Thomas as a center for excellence in nursing and nursing education, in which cutting-edge teaching and learning are integrated with practice and a focus on improving health outcomes and wellness of individuals and communities across Minnesota and beyond.

Inspired by Catholic intellectual tradition, the University of St. Thomas educates students to be morally responsible leaders who think critically, act wisely, and work skillfully to advance the common good. The University is a comprehensive university grounded in the liberal arts and the Catholic intellectual tradition that serves more than 10,000 students studying across eight academic colleges and schools. St. Thomas has metropolitan campuses in St. Paul, Minneapolis, and Rome and currently offers more than 90 undergraduate majors with opportunities for cross-disciplinary coursework in the liberal arts, and 60 graduate degree programs, including engineering, business, education and law. St. Thomas emphasizes a values-centered, career-oriented education, connecting students and alumni to the surrounding community through internships, career options, and partnerships.
