



Editor, *AAPS Advances in the Pharmaceutical Sciences Book Series*

Responsibilities

The Editor leads the series with vision, management, and scientific judgment. The Editor sets a strategy to achieve the series' stated objectives and works with the publisher Springer Nature and AAPS staff to implement that strategy together. The Editor oversees the scientific review of all proposals, ensuring timely review, feedback, and proposal development. The Editor solicits and develops high-quality content as part of the strategy and acts as an ambassador for the series and AAPS to the scientific community..

- **Set the strategy for the series.** The Editor monitors the competition and ensures that the series is a leading educational resource in the pharmaceutical sciences. The Editor works with AAPS staff and the publisher to ensure the series volumes address fundamental topics of interest and utility in the field, convening routinely to evaluate and adjust the strategy and tactics.
- **Oversee the scientific review of proposals.** The Editor will implement review procedures to judge the merit and utility of all book proposals to the *AAPS Advances* series. The Editor will conduct proposal reviews in a timely fashion.
- **Solicit and develop high-quality content.** The Editor will identify, target, and solicit informed and thorough topical volumes for the *AAPS Advances* series, with the help of AAPS staff and the publisher. The Editor will actively promote the series both privately and publicly as an ambassador and will work with staff and the publisher to do outreach to the scientific community in a variety of place-based and web-based ways.
- **Provide a steady flow of quality volumes for publication.** The Editor will develop and accept a steady flow of quality volumes for publication, in consultation with AAPS staff and the publisher.

Qualifications

- Strong knowledge of the pharmaceutical sciences and knowledge of educational topics and needs throughout the industrial, academic, regulatory, and consulting sectors of the field worldwide.
- Ability to develop a roster of experts who can advise on needs and topics in the field.
- Ability to articulate a vision for developing content, to reflect all areas of knowledge in the field.
- Experience as an editor or member of an editor team making decisions on content in pharmaceutical science books and with a record of contributing to the success of books in attracting good authors and their contributions.
- Ability to attract quality book editors and proposals.
- Ability to partner with AAPS staff and publisher to achieve book series goals.
