RightCapital	RightCapital is a great platform, despite minor limitations when compared to eMoney. It offers robust functionality, including the ability to flip between cash flow and goal-based planning, collect documents, and manage tasks all while being user-friendly and affordable.			
eMoney	eMoney's robust planning tools make complex financial analysis easy. Cash flow details are fully fleshed out, giving users a clear view of all inputs and assumptions with more control than RightCapital. However, that additional functionality comes with a higher price tag and a more complex user-interface.			
MoneyGuidePro	MoneyGuidePro, now owned by Envestnet, offers goal-based planning at a reasonable price. Its client-friendly user interface includes a "play zone" where clients (and advisors) can quickly adjust variables and create different planning scenarios. MoneyGuidePro is the best fit for advisors serving low-complexity clients or those using it alongside RightCapital / eMoney.
