Zoom	During the outbreak of COVID19, Zoom became a household name for video conferencing needs. Though there were a few instances of security breaches in the early days, those have been fully resolved. The platform allows access to meetings without requiring a download. It also offers additional non-core features, such as the ability to stream to Facebook live and chat outside of meetings.		
Webex	For webinars, Webex is a solid choice. It offers robust features and live support, plus additional add-ons like noise removal and speech enhancement. For one-on-one meetings, some users have reported that the interface is less intuitive compared to Zoom or GoToMeeting.		
GoTo Meeting	GoToMeeting boasts a simple, intuitive and user-friendly interface with consistently high call quality. However, it is quite limited as a standalone meeting platform and requires the addition of GoToWebinars for calls larger than 26 participants.
