Citrix Sharefile	Sharefile offers on-premise document storage and live support at a significantly higher price than Dropbox or Box. Smaller, remote-based firms are unlikely to find this justifies the significantly higher cost for the same features as Dropbox and Box.		
Dropbox	Dropbox offers an easy-to-use document storing and file-sharing system at a low cost. Its capability is nearly identical to Box with its primary advantage being the ability to preview links in the cloud system.		
Box	Box provides unlimited storage capacity, real time collaboration on MS Office files and the ability to request e-signatures within the system. When deciding between Dropbox and Box, the choice will likely boil down to storage capacity and user preference.
