



Diversity Dash Colour Run

This will come out with water.






There are three options that I can choose to participate in.




The first option will have obstacles I can go through or around. If I choose this option there will be people throwing colour at my clothes. This will be held on the outside of Oval B.



The second option will have obstacles I can go through or around. There will be no colour thrown at my clothes. This will be held on the inside of Oval B.




The third option will have other activities like bean bags, bubbles, bowling, chalk drawing and bean bag toss. This will be held in the Basketball Court B.






