Program Description: Join us for a presentation (webinar replay) and discussion about recognizing misconduct at the research site and developing local training programs to prevent misconduct. Presentation will include a case study from a facility where misconduct was discovered and the need for training programs.

Research misconduct and fraud makes headlines. Research site staff members may not be able to identify misconduct or may not fully understand the impact of such misconduct. This presentation is designed to assist research sites in recognizing misconduct and in developing local training programs to prevent misconduct. A case study of one large healthcare system's journey, one that began with discovery of fraud and ended with debarment of a team member, will be utilized to illustrate the need for a robust training program.
