

Sock Puppet

Instructions:

1. Place sock on hand, allow the child to watch you draw a face on the toe of the sock.
2. Begin singing and talking to the puppet.
3. Take the puppet off and allow the child to put on the puppet.
4. Make another puppet, model conversation/give each puppet time to respond.
5. Let the child play. Observe what the child does.
6. Play as long as the child shows interest.

Materials:

- Clean, light color adult sock
- Fabric markers
- A toddler book



What they learn:

Language: The child is fascinated with the language. The child is interested in the puppet talking.

Motor: Playing with the puppet allows the child to use small muscles in the child's hand and fingers.
