

Crazy Cups

Instructions:

1. Sit on the floor with the same size cups between you and the child. Observe what the child does with the cups.
2. Ask the child to help you stack the cups. Take turns stacking the cups one at a time.
3. When all cups are stacked, unstack the cups and explain what's being done as you unstack the cups.

Materials:

- 12 or more plastic cups of the same size
- Child's favorite book



What they learn:

Cognitive: Your child is exploring through trial and error.

Social and Emotional: Taking turns helps the child to socialize with others.

Motor: Stacking cups helps the child develop hand and eye coordination.
