Story Time

Instructions:

1. Place your baby on your lap.
2. Pick a story that you and baby have read together before.
3. Make sure and baby are in a comfortable position
4. Introduce the story to your baby make sure your baby can see your lips moving so he can see your mouth when you speak.
5. Begin to read the book.
6. Cuddle up and repeat this story again. Have a daily routine so your baby can get use to books.

Questions to ask your child:

- Can I read to you?
- Do you like this book?
- If you have a touch and feel book, you can talk to your child about what they see and help guide their hand over the touch and feel book.

What will your child learn?
