### Read to Me: Interacting and Bonding

#### Instructions:

1. Place your baby on your lap.
2. Make sure you and the baby are in a comfortable position.
3. Introduce the story to your baby. Make sure your baby can see your lips moving and can see your mouth when you speak.
4. Begin to read the book.
5. Cuddle up and repeat this story again.

#### Questions to ask your child:

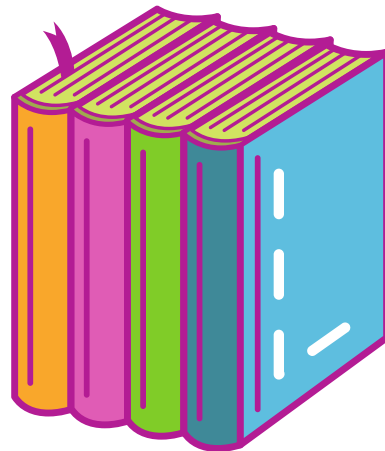
- Do you see the brown bear in the story?
- If you have a touch and feel book, you can talk to your child about what they see. Help guide their hand over the touch and feel book.

#### What will your child learn?

**Language:** Reading sets the stage for your baby to learn new words. Once your baby gets used to the routine of being read to, he can predict what comes next. Many of his first words may come from books you may have read over and over.
