Age Group: 3 to 5-year-old

Objective: Literacy

Me Too!

Instructions:

1. Tell your child "B makes the Bu sound."
2. When your child knows the sound, tell them to jump every time they hear a word that begins with B.
3. Call out words that begin with 'B' (Ball, baby, Bounce, Banana). Occasionally say a word beginning with a different letter (School), so your child can hear the difference.

Repeat with different letters

Questions to ask your child:

1. What else begins with B?
2. Why didn't you jump when I said school?



What will children learn?

The child will learn to discriminate the sound in language, name letters, use sound knowledge and follow directions.

Learning Objectives:

- Demonstrates phonological awareness
- Notices and discriminates smaller units of sounds.
