

LEGO Color Sort

Instructions:

1. Choose the colors you would like your child(ren) to sort out (i.e. red, blue and yellow).
2. If you'd like, you can use masking tape to tape the paper to the table or floor.
3. With your child, take out a LEGO or block and decide what paper it matches with.
4. Let your child continue to match LEGOS or blocks to colored paper.
5. Add more colors as your child continues.

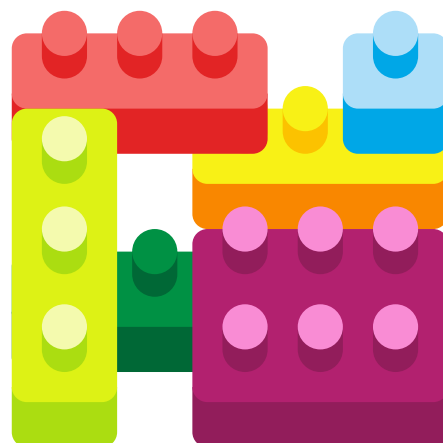
How to extend the activity:

This is a good opportunity to introduce shades of color. You can talk to your child about how colors are alike, but may come in different shades like lighter or darker red.

You can extend this activity with anything! If you go outside, you can sort the colors of falling leaves.

Materials:

- Colored paper
- Colored LEGOS or blocks,
- Masking tape (Optional)



What they learn:

Cognitive Skills: Children are practicing their cognitive skills by practicing how to match like colors and color recognition.

Language Skills: By saying each color aloud, they are practicing saying and pronouncing their colors.
