

Age Group: 3-5 year old

Objective: Observation, The Five Senses

Box Cars

Instructions:

1. The child will choose a desired size box to create their car.
2. Ask the child to decorate the box using any art materials of their choice.
3. Take a picture to display for e-learning "Box Car Show".
Parents can share the photo with their child's teacher.

Questions to extend learning:

- What is special about your car?
- What shape is your car?
- What is a box made of?
- What did you use to create your car?
- Can we use boxes for many purposes?
- What color is your car?
- Why did you design your car that way?

Materials:

- 1 Medium or large or extra-large size cardboard box
- Paint, markers, crayons, or other art materials of choice
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue



What will children learn?

Children will learn to engage in imaginative play while learning a lot about engineering and technology. Children role playing such as driving a car has lots of benefits in supporting social, cognitive and language development.

Learning Objectives:

- Respond appropriately to questions from others.
- Provide comments relevant to the context.
- Use language for a variety of purposes.
- Student will make observations about an object.
- Students will verbally explain their observation in at least 4-6 words.
- Students will use their five senses to further understand an object.
