

Age Group: 3-5 year old

Objective: Mathematics

Dot Number Match

Instructions:

1. Cut out 10 squares (cut 20 squares to challenge your child).
2. Draw the same number of dots on two squares.
3. Have the child match two squares with the same amount of dots.

Questions to extend learning:

- How many dots are on each half?
- What other things can we count?

Materials:

- One side of a cereal box
- Black marker or any color marker



What will children learn?

The child will learn to identify number quantity and matching.

Learning Objectives:

- Children will match the dots on each cardboard box (matching and counting game).
- Uses number concepts and operations
- Counts matching
