



Learning At Home Activity

Age Group: 2-year-old

Objective: Gross Motor and Language

Flashlight Tag

Instructions:

1. Give flashlight to the child.
2. Family member will instruct the child to turn on the flashlight.
3. Family member will inform the child that it is nighttime.
4. Family member will instruct child that they will have to run around and tag (the light touches the body) someone with the light.
5. The child and Family members will run around trying to tag each other with the flashlights.

Questions to extend learning:

- How do you turn on the flashlight?
- What time of the day is it when it's dark?
- What do you see in the sky?

Materials:

- Flashlights
- Dark indoor and/or outdoor area.



What will children learn?

The child will learn how to follow directions. Parents can extend this activity by having the child look at the stars and the moon in the sky. Also, explore some of the nighttime animal life and bugs. The child will be learning gross motor and language.
