

Age Group: 2-year-old

Objective: Language

Red Light Green Light Game

Instructions:

1. Parents create a red (stop) circle and a green (go) circle.
2. Ask the child to stand at the starting point.
3. Parents explain that they are a car and must stop when they see the red circle and go when they see the green circle.
4. When Parents hold up the circle, the child must complete the task.
5. When the child gets to the second line the game is over.

Questions to extend learning:

- What colors do you see?
- What shape do you see?
- How many shapes are the same?
- How would you walk, fast or slow?

Materials:

- Red (stop) and Green (go) Circles



What will children learn?

The child will learn how to identify shapes and colors. Parents can extend learning by asking the child about where they go in a car. When do we use a traffic light and how it lights up. The child will be learning through gross motor, mathematics, and language.
