



## Learning At Home Activity

**Age Group: 3-5 year old**

**Objective: Spatial Relationships  
and Shapes**

### Sort and Drop

**Instructions:**

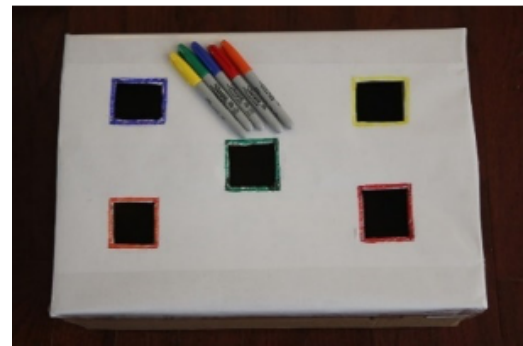
1. Cut five openings in the box.
2. Pick five colored crayons (red, blue, green, yellow, or orange).
3. Color around each opening using the five colors (red, blue, green, yellow, or orange).
4. Ask your child to pick a colored shape piece of paper, or a colored object to drop into the colored slot that matches.

**Questions to extend learning:**

- What is your favorite color?
- What shape is that object or piece of paper?
- How many are you dropping inside the slot?
- Can you match the objects with the colored slots?

**Materials:**

- Boxes of any size
- Colored paper, shapes or Small colored objects
- Crayons
- scissors (to cut openings into the box)



**What will children learn?**

The child will learn to sort colors, recognize colors, count, build fine motor skills, and match colors.

**Learning Objectives:**

- Children will be able to sort colors and recognize shapes.
- Explores and describes spatial relationships and shapes.
- Understand shapes.
