### The Name Game

#### Instructions:

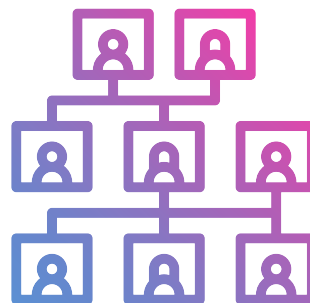
1. Write the names of every person in your family on a piece of paper, index card or strips of paper.
2. Hold up the name cards one at a time and hide some of the letters.
3. Slowly reveal the letters one at a time. Let your child know which family member the card belongs to.
4. Cover the letters again and now ask your child the name of the letters as you uncover them.
5. Place 2 small boxes on the table. Put the name your child recognizes in one of the boxes and the name your does not recognize in the other box.

#### Questions to extend learning:

- I uncovered the first letter of the name. Do you know whose name it is?
- As you reveal more letters ask; What letter will we see next?
- Can you find the card with your name on it?
- What letters do you recognize?

#### Materials:

- Paper, Index cards or strips of paper
- Pen, pencil or marker
- 2 small boxes



#### What will children learn?

- Alphabet recognition.
- Identify and name letters.
- Child will identify their name.
- Identify family members' names.

#### Learning Objectives:

- Children will be able to demonstrate knowledge of the alphabet and identify their name.
- Identifies and name letters.
