Instructions:

1. Gather the pictures.
2. Sit next to the child and name each person in the picture. Have the child point to the picture as you say their name.
3. Describe what you see in the picture and ask the child to also describe what they see.
4. Encourage the child to imitate the name of the person and use vocabulary to describe who they see and what they see.

Questions to extend learning:

- Who do you see in the picture?
- What are they doing?
- Who is this in the picture?

- Pictures of family, relatives, or friends
