What to do:

Choose a few books that you would think your student would not mind acting out. Make sure the story is one they are familiar with, such as Goldilocks and the Three Bears or Caps for Sale. Read the story and ask the student what happened and what will happen next. Talk about the characters roles and ask your child to act out his favorite character. As your student acts out the story, parents may serve as a narrator to direct the student. Feel free to use props or costumes if you like.
