Let's Explore Outdoors!

Directions: Go outside and explore outdoors on a sunny day! Grab your camera or phone and take pictures of things you see! Take pictures of bugs, sun, grass, flowers, frogs, birds, people, cars, and stores. If the child does not have access to a phone or a camera, have them record in their mind. They can create what they saw by drawing it.

Questions to ask your child:

- Why did you take a picture of that?
- Do bugs have a home?
- What kind of car is that?
- Does the sunshine everyday?
- Are you going to be a photographer when you grow up or a child photographer"?
- Why are numbers on houses?
- Ask open-ended questions using, who, what, when, where, why and how?
- Parents are encouraged to expand on vocabulary words.
