

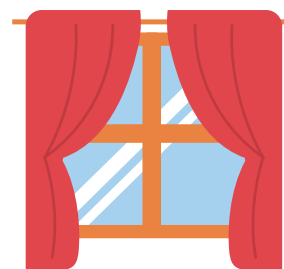
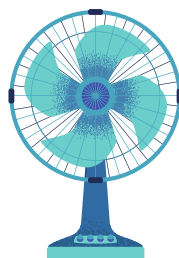
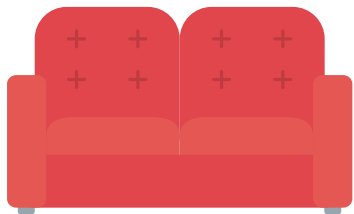
Hunting for Sounds Around the House

Instructions:

- Walk around and find objects around the house that begin with the letter sounds /C/S/R/P/W/F/B/H/D/J/.
- Identify the letter, sound, and object.
- Example: "C" say /C/ and C is for Couch.
"S" say /S/ and S is for Shirt.

Materials

Objects
from around the house
(Couch, Stove, Refrigerator,
Purse, Window, Radio,
Pillow, Fork, Shoe, Bed,
Hanger, Door,
Jelly, etc.)
