

## Mystery Words

### What to do:

1. Write 5-10 sight words on the white paper using the white crayon. Make sure to space the words out so they do not overlap.
2. Dip the paintbrush into the water to soften the bristles.
3. Paint over the words with the watercolor paint to make the mystery words appear.

### Materials:

1. Sight Word Cards or List
2. White Paper
3. White Crayon
4. Water Color Paint & Paintbrush
5. Cup of Water

### Questions to extend learning:

- What colors do you see?
- What does this word say?
- What letters do you see?
- How do you hold your crayon or paintbrush?
- Which color would you like to use first?



**Why is this activity important?** This mystery word activity is important because it helps children recognize sight words, common signs, and labels in the environment. It helps children recognize colors and art concepts. This activity also fosters fine motor development by using the paintbrush and crayons to paint and write.
