

Scavenger Hunt

What to do:

1. Have your child walk around the house and search for an item that is their favorite color. "Ask what color is it?" and "Why it is your favorite color?"
2. Have your child to walk around the house and pick out their favorite toy. Ask "Why is this your favorite toy?" and "What do you like about this toy?"
3. Have your child to walk around the house and search for an item that begins with the first letter of their name. Discuss what letter their name begins with and what it looks like. Write the first letter of their name on a sheet of paper and show them what it looks like.

Extend the activity:

1. Ask your child to find specific items like A red spoon or a blue dress.
2. Write your child's answers and let them draw pictures of the items they found.

Your child will be following directions, connecting words to items, and identifying their favorites then explaining why these items are their favorites.
