

TELL A STORY DRAWING!

What to do:

1. With your child, pick some story topics to choose from.
2. Parents, explain to your children that you are going to tell a story together by taking turns drawing illustrations for each part of the story. Stories should have a beginning, middle and an end.
 - For Example, stories can be about: Our day ..., Before bed we..., or My Favorite...
3. After choosing the story, assist your child in illustrating the story. First, draw your part of the illustration, then ask the child to identify or name what you drew. Then encourage your child to draw their part and add drawings and add on words to complete and tell the story.

Materials:

- Story Ideas/Books
- Scrap Paper
- Pencils, Crayons



Why is this activity important?

Literacy: Teaching children literacy through storytelling encourages their curiosity and imagination. This activity also increases their willingness to communicate, express their thoughts, feelings, focus and social skills.
