

Sorting

What to do:

- Explain to your child/children that you are going to play a sorting game.
- Place the items on the table and show the child/children what you want them to do.

Materials:

Socks of different sizes or colors, or different size eating utensils, or whatever you choose



Why is this activity important?

Sorting is a beginning math skill and by sorting, children learn similarities, differences and how to compare. You can blindfold the child/children to make sorting a little more challenging.
