

Emoji and Monster Expressions

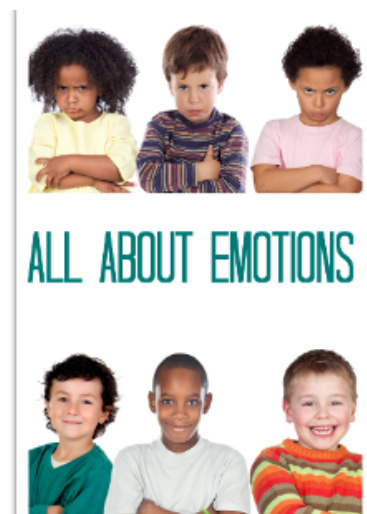
What to do:

1. Ask your child to think of six emotions. Draw the six emojis and six monsters with the feelings your child picked. Mix and match Emoji feelings with a monster feeling for a fun recognition game.
2. Write the words on the image so your child can identify letters and words like “sad” or “happy.”
3. Listen to and watch the YouTube video “Emoji in English and Spanish.” Have the child express and dramatize each feeling. Everyone can participate in expressing feelings. Try this song from the “Emotion Hokey Pokey” YouTube video. Enjoy with your family!



Materials:

- 12 plain cards
- Color pencils, crayons or markers
- Television, tablet or phone with Wi-Fi connection



Why is this activity important?

This activity can be expanded in various ways, from expressing feelings and understanding different emotions to learning to recall words. Your child can recognize letters and words and say them to develop their language skills. The whole family can participate by listening and watching these videos that show how to express feelings. It is also fun to play “Emotion Hokey Pokey!”
