

Alphabet Phonics

What to do:

1. Show your child the alphabet and identify the letter and sound.
2. Have your child say the letter while bouncing the ball.
3. Say the sound of the letter your child has chosen.
4. Encourage your child to say the letter and the sound while bouncing the ball

Materials:

- Beach ball (write letters on the ball)
- Paper, pencil, crayons or markers
- Alphabet cards or write letters on paper

Questions to ask your child:

1. What is this letter? Show the letter.
2. Tell me the sound of the letter?
3. What is the first letter of your name and what sound does the letter make?



Why is this activity important?

This activity is important because it teaches children how to identify alphabet letters and the sound of each letter. Letter sounds are the building blocks of words.

Learning Objective: To teach children letters and sounds of the alphabet.
