



## **Sight Words Search**

#### What to do:

**Prep:** Write sight words on top of pieces of tape, and then place individual piece of tape on each egg or container. So, each egg has a word on the top.

**Directions:** Choose a small object to hide under the egg or container. Have your child close their eyes and hide the object underneath. In order for your child to lift and look under the egg they need to read the sight word. If they do not know it, you may help sound it out, or tell them the word, and then have them repeat it. Play several rounds moving the object underneath the egg.

#### **Materials**

Plastic eggs or small containers Tape Marker Small toy or coin





# Start with a few words, then slowly increase the number of words. Suggestion of sight words are below:

Parent names a sight word, and the child needs to find it by sight. Young children can also do this activity just change it to colors or make shapes on the tape.
