
Welcome to ERC and Pathlight Continuing Education Events!

Our continuing education process is handled online through our Litmos learning management system. Within a few days you will receive an email from "ERC and Pathlight Continuing Education Events" <system@litmos.com> inviting you to log in to our system and join the course titled "XXXXXXXX". You can login using your email as your username and then set your own password. If you receive a message stating that the registration link is no longer valid you may already have an account with us. Once you are logged in you will be brought to your home page. It will look like this:





Depending on your settings, courses may be displayed in list form as above or in tiles as below.




Each tile/ item in the list will bring you to the course homepage where you will find the assessments for each of the presentations.


On the course homepage you will hit the "start this course" button in yellow. You will be brought to a white screen with another "start" button. Hit that start button and you will be asked a series of questions about the presentation and speaker(s) (Figure 1).



Please complete all of the questions. These make up the post-test and evaluation. If you scroll down a bit on the page you will see a results tab that will allow you to view any questions that you may have answered incorrectly on the post-test as well as the correct answers to those questions. My understanding is that some of the questions can be tricky \odot .



Once you have answered all of the questions you will be returned to the homepage and you will see a green circle that says 100%. There is a tab on the lower left-hand side of the screen labeled "Achievements" - Click this tab.



There will be a line with the title of the presentation, the date, and "download certificate" printed in tangerine. Click on "download certificate" and your certificate will download to your device.
