

## Outstanding Young Philanthropists Layups for Lucy



Each year since 2014, over fifty students at Neshannock High School have held a fundraiser to honor the memory of Lucy Beal and to raise money for UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh.

Layups for Lucy has donated over \$180,000 to the Children's Hospital, given individual grants to students and families to help offset ongoing medical expenses, and has been a major supporter of Camp Wakchazi, the area's only sibling bereavement camp.

This group of students, created by Grace Beal and now led by Neshannock senior Eliza Beal, organizes and plans all aspects of the annual Layups for Lucy fundraiser. At the event itself, the students do everything from collecting admissions to announcing the student/faculty game to manning the tables of raffle baskets and concessions. They also hold a summer meeting and cornhole tournament. Last year, they put on a drive in movie so that they could have a COVID safe event for the entire community.

## Outstanding Volunteer Fundraising Group Lou Blaney Family Volunteers



Kate Blaney and her family have been a major catalyst in raising funds and awareness of Alzheimer's Disease. Under the leadership and dedicated efforts of Kate Blaney, the volunteer group has held the Lou Blaney Memorial Race at Sharon Speedway in Trumbull County for thirteen years. Lou was a sprint car driver at the Sharon Speedway. He also raced nationally and was inducted into the Sprint Hall of Fame.

After years of marriage, raising two sons, and working together at the Blaney lumber company, Lou and Kate's journey together took an unexpected turn in 2002. Lou sustained a head injury which resulted in a diagnosis of Alzheimer's Disease. The Blaney family turned to the professional staff of Alzheimer's Association of Greater East Ohio for care, support, and education. Because of the tremendous help they received from the Alzheimer's Association, the Blaney family knew their philanthropic efforts would be directed to the Alzheimer's Association and its support of families navigating this disease.

Since Lou's passing, the annual Lou Blaney Memorial Race raises funds to support the Mahoning Valley Walk to End Alzheimer's. This year, the Blaney family raised the largest amount - \$23,000. In addition, Lou and Kate's grandson, Ryan, who has been very successful as a NASCAR driver, has contributed many thousands of dollars from his personal foundation to support the effort.

Kate's inspiration in the community has been widespread having been named the Alzheimer's Association 2011 Honoree. She has also served as a member of the Guardian Angels, a volunteer group appointed by the Trumbull County Probate Court, to help older adults without family or caregivers to accommodate their needs.

## Outstanding Volunteer Fundraiser

### Scott R. Schulick



Scott R. Schulick is First Vice-President/Investments for Stifel, Nicolaus & Co., Inc. He has devoted time and energy to raise money for nearly every civic organization that he has been involved, especially the formation and support for Youngstown Cityscape. He has been active in numerous civic boards and committees throughout his career, including Rotary Club of Youngstown, Mahoning Valley Historical Society, Community Corrections Association, Diocese of Youngstown Foundation, Youngstown State University Foundation, Rich Center for Autism and Stambaugh Auditorium.

Scott began his volunteer fundraising efforts at an early age attending St. Brendan School by selling World's Finest Chocolate and being the top seller at Ursuline High School's annual raffle calendar drive. These humble fundraising initiatives sparked an interest to raise money for Catholic schools which continued long after his graduation as he helped to establish the St. Brendan School Endowment Fund, chairing multiple fundraising events, and co-chairing a city-wide event with The Youngstown Symphony, "Christmas in the City," to support the Catholic Schools across Youngstown.

Education has always been a key component of Scott's fundraising activities. Scott believes that in order to advance our region, we must advance the education attainment level of our citizens, with scholarship endowments a key to achieving that goal. He has been an active volunteer fundraiser on nearly every Youngstown State University initiative over the past 25 years, most recently a cabinet member of the successful "We See Tomorrow" campaign.

Scott is recruited from time to time by friends associated with community organizations and projects to assist in fundraising efforts and has rarely said "no." One project has often led to another. He usually has a ticket in his pocket, or pledge form in his folder to share with his next donor. He finds great satisfaction in helping individuals in need and in seeing new projects completed for the advancement of our community.

## Outstanding Small Business Philanthropist

Some of those efforts include: installing smoke detectors for the American Red Cross, fundraising and participating in the American Heart Association Heart Walk, the American Cancer Society Relay for Life, and the Junior Achievement Bowl-a-thon. They have also held several food drives for the Second Harvest Food Bank and an annual Holiday Giving Campaign.

On a personal level, David enjoys weekends fishing and spending time with his partner, Beverly. He also loves sharing moments with his granddaughters Sophie and Aubrey. Andrew spends most of his time playing volleyball, spending time with friends and family, and enjoying Indians' baseball, Browns' football, and all Notre Dame sports.

## Special Recognition for Valley Impact

### Ellen J. Tressel



Born in Youngstown, OH and raised in the suburb of Canfield, Ellen J. Tressel has been an active advocate and leader for the state of Ohio throughout her adult career. A proud graduate of Youngstown State University with a degree in Business Education, Ellen has since had her hands wrapped around the region's economic activities and community causes.

Landing her first job working for The Youngstown Welding and Engineering Company she worked her way up to Director of Purchasing until the role of motherhood called. Returning to the workforce after a brief interlude, she worked for Jostens Printing and Publishing, and Butler Wick and Co. earning the role of Vice President of Trading. She obtained several licenses in the securities business while managing marketing, sales, product promotion, OTC equities and new product introduction until her "retirement" in July 2001.

In her leisure time, you may find her on the golf course or swimming pool enjoying the great outdoors.

From then on, and most notably, Ellen has spent her time giving back to the community while serving on numerous boards and service organizations ranging from the James Cancer Hospital Foundation board, Akron Children's Hospital Foundation board and COSI in Columbus, OH - just to name a few.

Currently, Ellen resides at the Pollock House with her husband Jim Tressel in Youngstown, OH and serves on the boards of The Beatitude House, Mahoning Valley Historical Society, and the "We See Tomorrow" Capital Campaign for Youngstown State University.

## Legacy Award

### Marion G. Resch



Born and raised in Youngstown, Ohio, Marion Gilchrist Resch prepared for college at The Rayen School and earned her undergraduate degree from Lake Erie College in Painesville, OH, where she was a member of the Kappa Alpha Sigma Honor Society. Returning to Youngstown, Mrs. Resch briefly taught at Chaney High School and pursued a part time career in radio and television. Her first venture in 1942 was reviewing current best-selling books on the WFMJ radio program "All About Books". The program received honorable mention in the cultural division among awards made at the Ohio State Radio Education Convention. Mrs. Resch assisted in the development of similar programs at other radio stations in the region.

In 1937, Marion Gilchrist married Paul Hadtner Resch, a stockbroker and partner at Butler Wick & Co Brokerage. While the Resches had no children of their own, they took special interest in their nieces and nephews as well as educational opportunities available to students in the Mahoning Valley. She supported many students and educational programs at area colleges and universities with the hopes of helping those students reach their potential. To ensure that support would continue, she founded The Marion G. Resch Foundation in 1997.

The Foundation supports three major initiatives: (1) an Early Identification Program (EIP) which partners a college with a local high school to find and work with promising first generation high school students to encourage them to pursue a college education; (2) scholarships for eligible students which cover remaining expenses, after all other forms of aid are exhausted, to alleviate student debt; and (3) to support college academic support centers which help students develop skills to assist them in completing their college degree. Since Mrs. Resch's passing, the Marion G. Resch Foundation has awarded over \$18 million dollars to students in the valley and continues to support EIP Programs at the College of Wooster, University of Mount Union, Thiel College and Westminster College. Mrs. Resch's generosity and legacy is set to continue in perpetuity.

## Outstanding Philanthropists Greg & Alice Greenwood
