Primary Responsibilities:

Relationship Building and Management

- Manage relationships with established corporate partners.
- Actively research and vet new corporate prospects.
- Engage in conversations with brands around reducing their plastic supply chain.
- Work with partners to co-create deliverables and ensure deliverables are met.
- Work with 5 Gyres Digital Strategist to ensure content from partners is shared.
- Create partnership decks for general operating support, programs, and events as needed.
- Write email appeals and work with 5 Gyres Digital Strategist on communications strategy.
- Invite donors to key events.
- Engage leadership in donor cultivation, solicitation, and stewardship.
- Attend relevant conferences, trade shows, and events for networking purposes.
- Present on 5 Gyres behalf at corporate and donor cultivation events.
- Assist with special projects and events as needed.

Operations and Logistics

- Participate in weekly staff meetings.
- Lead bi-weekly Corporate and Donor meetings.
- Produce corporate partnership and donor reports for quarterly board meetings.
- Engage team in regular updates.
- Track pledges for the finance committee.
- Draft, review, and sign M.O.U.s with corporate partners.
- Work with 5 Gyres Operations Manager to provide invoices and receipts to partners.
- Ensure donors are thanked in an appropriate and timely manner.
- Monitor Kindful and notify development team about major gifts.

- 5+years experience in nonprofit development, with a focus on corporate partnerships and donor development.
- Passion for and knowledge of the plastic pollution issue.
- Basic understanding of packaging, alternative materials, and delivery systems.
- Experience creating partnership decks.
- Experience writing email appeals and engaging donors.
- Experience using a nonprofit C.R.M., such as Kindful.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office Suite.
- Creative, strategic thinker, organized, detail-oriented, and able to handle multiple tasks simultaneously in a fast-paced environment.
