



Chapter Fund Scholarships Application Guidelines for 2019

Rules:

- The purpose of Chapter Fund scholarships is to allow AFP-GLAC members to participate in educational activities which would not otherwise be affordable or reimbursed.
- Scholarships shall be awarded for educational pursuits such as: attending monthly AFP development seminar/luncheon, membership incentive for new and renewing members, AFP-GLAC Regional Philanthropy Conference and the Ralph E. Chamberlain scholarship.
- Applicants must submit a written application to the Philanthropy Committee. All deadlines for scholarships must be adhered to. The applicant may be contacted by phone or scheduled for an interview for further information.
- The Committee will review and approve or decline the application within a timely manner.
- During any given year, an AFP-GLAC member may receive total scholarships up to a maximum of \$1,000. Total number of scholarships available depends on the Chapter Fund annual budget.

Applicants must:

- Be a member of AFP-GLAC for at least one year unless otherwise stated.
- Must attend at least one meeting and/or roundtable from the beginning of their membership to the time of application for the scholarship.
- Must attend at least one meeting and/or roundtable after receiving the scholarship and be available to report to the members

Preference will be given to those who have donated to the AFP Foundation and/or Chapter Fund and who have volunteered and will volunteer to support chapter activities.

Scholarship Recipients must:

- Turn in all receipts from their expenditures for reimbursement as necessary.
- Write and submit a half-page report describing two or three lessons learned or practical tips gained from their experience.
- Be willing to speak briefly about their experience at a meeting if requested.
- Be willing to volunteer in some capacity for AFP-GLAC.
