2. Supporting documentation is accepted, however, will only be used to enhance the narrative and will not be considered if the narrative does not address the criteria. No more than 10 pages of supporting documentation will be considered. The narrative should reference the supporting documentation. Information from the supporting documents, but not included in the narrative **will not** be considered by the judges.
3. Each complete application will include three pieces: 1.) Nomination form, 2.) Narrative answering criteria questions and 3.) Supporting documents. All nominations, including letters of support, must be submitted online in a PDF or Word document. Please include the award category for which the nomination is being submitted in the subject line of the email.

## **2021 NPD Nomination Form Criteria Questions**

### **Category - Outstanding Business/Corporation/Foundation in Philanthropy**

This award honors a business, corporation, or foundation that demonstrates outstanding commitment through financial support and through encouragement of others to take leadership roles toward philanthropy and community involvement. Through its consistent philanthropic efforts, the quality of life in Alaska communities has been substantially improved.

Nominations will be considered based on the responses to the following criteria:

1. Evidence of philanthropic support of innovative approaches to solving problems in Alaska. (0-45 points)
2. Description of impact of gift support and achievements accomplished through the business, corporation or foundation's efforts. (0-40 points)
3. Evidence of encouragement and motivation given to others to take leadership roles toward philanthropy and community involvement. (0-15 points)
