2. Supporting documentation is accepted, however, will only be used to enhance the narrative and will not be considered if the narrative does not address the criteria. No more than 10 pages of supporting documentation will be considered. The narrative should reference the supporting documentation. Information from the supporting documents, but not included in the narrative **will not** be considered by the judges.
3. Each complete application will include three pieces: 1.) Nomination form, 2.) Narrative answering criteria questions and 3.) Supporting documents. All nominations, including letters of support, must be submitted online in a PDF or Word document. Please include the award category for which the nomination is being submitted in the subject line of the email.

## **2021 NPD Nomination Form Criteria Questions**

### **Category - Outstanding Individual or Family Philanthropist**

This award honors an Alaska individual or family with a proven record of exceptional generosity who, through direct financial support, demonstrates outstanding civic and charitable responsibility and whose generosity encourages others to be philanthropic.

Nominations will be considered based on responses to the following criteria:

1. Description of participation in and leadership gift support of nonprofit organizations in Alaska. (0-50 points)
2. Demonstrated leadership role in encouraging and motivating others to give. (0-30 points)
3. Description of strategic, planned approach to giving support to community efforts that reflect personal values. (0-20 points)

Note: Previous award recipients may be honored again, but preference will be given to individuals who have not received an award.
