2. Supporting documentation is accepted, however, will only be used to enhance the narrative and will not be considered if the narrative does not address the criteria. No more than 10 pages of supporting documentation will be considered. The narrative should reference the supporting documentation. Information from the supporting documents, but not included in the narrative **will not** be considered by the judges.
3. Each complete application will include three pieces: 1.) Nomination form, 2.) Narrative answering criteria questions and 3.) Supporting documents. All nominations, including letters of support, must be submitted online in a PDF or Word document. Please include the award category for which the nomination is being submitted in the subject line of the email.

2021 NPD Nomination Form Criteria Questions
Category - Outstanding Professional in Philanthropy

This award honors an outstanding individual in the field of fundraising or philanthropy in Alaska. Nominees must possess a CFRE or ACFRE certification. Nominees must currently spend a majority of their time on fundraising or philanthropy efforts and be a current member of the AFP Alaska Chapter. Nominations from AFP members are welcome with the selection of the award recipient at the sole discretion of the AFP Alaska Chapter Board of Directors.

Nominations will be considered based on the responses to the following criteria:

1. Description of career achievements, length and tenure of fundraising background, experience and results. The recipient must have at least 10 years professional fundraising experience. (0-25 points)
2. Evidence of quality of leadership that is effective, creative and stimulating, and that the individual acts as a team player. (0-20 points)
3. Membership in AFP and evidence that the individual practices and promotes the AFP Code of Ethical Principles and Standards of Professional Practice for fundraising professionals. (0-20 points)
4. Description of individual's commitment to advancing the fundraising profession through continuing professional development, including certification (CFRE or ACFRE), involvement in AFP chapter activities, conference participation, publication and professional education. (0-15 points)
5. Evidence of commitment to fundraising and philanthropy through voluntary service and financial support of nonprofit organizations. (0-20 points)
