Information from the supporting documents, but not included in the narrative **will not** be considered by the judges.
3. Each complete application will include three pieces: 1.) Nomination form, 2.) Narrative answering criteria questions and 3.) Supporting documents. All nominations, including letters of support, must be submitted online in a PDF or Word document. 2021 NPD Nomination Form Criteria Questions

Category – Eugene R. Wilson Award

The Eugene R. Wilson Award will be presented to an individual who, through their actions and activities, has contributed to the development of a philanthropic culture in Alaska. This award can be given to a professional fundraiser, major/significant donor, funder, nonprofit staff or board member, or any individual deserving of special recognition for her/his significant contribution to philanthropy in Alaska.

Nominations from AFP members are welcome with the selection of the award recipient at the sole discretion of the AFP Alaska Chapter Board of Directors and the NPD Selection Committee. The Eugene R. Wilson Award will be given periodically and is reserved for those deserving this special recognition. This award will be open for nominations on an annual basis, but might not be awarded each year.
