



With assets of \$330 million invested, Greater Toledo Community Foundation (GTCF) gives away approximately \$18 million annually to causes important to the Toledo region. GTCF helps donors focus on the rewards of giving, not administrative details. As a community foundation, we are uniquely flexible in helping philanthropists meet their personal goals. Any GTCF fund can be used to make grants anonymously or with full acknowledgment, now or in the future.
