NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the Year Ended December 31, 2016

Note 1. Purpose of the Organization:

The Association represents over 30,000 members in 230 chapters in Canada, the United States, Mexico, and China working to advance philanthropy through advocacy, research, education, and certification programs. The Manitoba Chapter, with a membership of 218, is one of twenty Canadian chapters with a total membership of 3,500.

Note 2. AFP Leadership Retreat

AFP Manitoba Chapter made a contribution of \$1,500 in support of the Leadership Retreat resulting in a net income of \$656. Those funds were allocated to the Every Member Campaign.

Note 3. Special Projects Fund

During the year the Board initiated a fund for non-recurring projects. From this fund, \$5,000 was disbursed as a donation to the AFP Foundation in support of the 2017 "What Donors Want" research project, and the remainder of \$1,275 was disbursed in support of the AFP Twentieth Anniversary celebration.

Note 4. Income Tax Provision:

No provision for income taxes has been made in these statements since the Association was incorporated as a not-for-profit organization.

Note 5. Remuneration of Board Members:

The AFP Manitoba Chapter is administered by a board of volunteers elected annually at a special meeting of members for ratification at the Annual General Meeting. No remuneration for services is paid to any volunteer board member.

Note 6. Statement of Changes in Financial Position:
