

Emerging Leader in Philanthropy Nomination

- 1. Detail what the nominee accomplished, including goals, process, budget (if relevant) and other people involved in the process (friends, adviser, charitable organization etc.) and of the time, talent and/or treasure given for the common good and the results that were achieved.
- 2. Describe the impact the nominee had on the community, including numbers of people involved, financial impact, organizations helped, etc. Please include the names and contact information of individuals at the organizations who benefited from the nominee's work.
- 3. What was the long term (3-5 years) impact of the nominee's work? Will the project(s) be ongoing and has the nominee considered next steps or is working on other projects? Did the actions of this person(s) motivate or encourage others to get involved or increase their involvement in your organization?
- 4. Provide evidence that the nominee is a leader in the charitable sector and committed to helping other with project(s) or guidance.

Other Requirements:

- Head shot/Logo for nominee.
- 3-5 one-page letters of support.

Confirmation of the following:

- I understand that all those nominated for an award will be mentioned in the program and a print ad leading up to the event.
- I have informed the nominee they may be interviewed by the media and there is agreement to be interviewed at a convenient time and date.
- I have asked the nominee if they are willing to sit for formal photographs and they have agreed to do so.
- I have informed the nominee, if selected as the recipient they receive two complimentary tickets for themselves and a guest to attend the Manitoba Philanthropy Day Awards and Luncheon in November. All nominees will receive one complementary ticket for the Manitoba Philanthropy Awards Luncheon. Additional tickets can be purchased at the early bird or regular rate.
- I have informed the nominee they will be asked to participate in a video as part of the Manitoba Philanthropy Day Awards and Luncheon and they agreed to do so.
