

Outstanding Volunteer Fundraiser Nomination

- 1. Provide evidence of past and present leadership roles and responsibilities as well as the ability to support fundraising campaigns, including but not limited to annual campaigns, special projects or events, and capital campaigns. Include the impact the nominee and their work has had on the organization's ability to provide programs and services to the community.
- 2. Describe the time, effort and personal commitment to the causes the nominee chooses to support through their volunteering.
- 3. Highlight the impact and/or innovative approaches to philanthropy. Provide examples of creative fundraising ideas and implementation that the organization may not have used in the past. Identify innovative and entrepreneurial thinking that has developed a new revenue stream or created partnerships that did not exist in the past.
- 4. Provide evidence in recruiting and motivating others, demonstrating a commitment to philanthropy, emphasizing the overall commitment to charitable work and volunteerism.
- 5. Describe the nominees participation and support of other not for profit organizations locally, provincially, nationally or internationally. He or she may have not led fundraising efforts but was active on boards and committees and gave and volunteers to the organization. Include evidence of this individual's involvement in a broad cross section of organizations, demonstrating an overall commitment to philanthropy and volunteerism participation at a variety of levels of fundraising.

Other Requirements:

- Head shot/Logo for nominee. 3-5 one-page letters of support.

Confirmation of the following:

- I understand that all those nominated for an award will be mentioned in the program and a print ad leading up to the event.
- I have informed the nominee they may be interviewed by the media and there is agreement to be interviewed at a convenient time and date.



- I have asked the nominee if they are willing to sit for formal photographs and they have agreed to do so.
- I have informed the nominee, if selected as the recipient they receive two complimentary tickets for themselves and a guest to attend the Manitoba Philanthropy Day Awards and Luncheon in November. All nominees will receive one complementary ticket for the Manitoba Philanthropy Awards Luncheon. Additional tickets can be purchased at the early bird or regular rate.
- I have informed the nominee they will be asked to participate in a video as part of the Manitoba Philanthropy Day Awards and Luncheon and they agreed to do so.
