



Outstanding Philanthropist Nomination

1. Describe the impact this individual has had on your organization. Include information about specific areas of supports and the leadership provided to organizations based on giving.
2. Outline how the nominee encouraged and motivated others to take leadership roles in philanthropy. Include leadership roles such as campaign chair, foundation volunteer, board president or other volunteer involvement that is fundraising related. Include evidence of involvement in recruiting and managing fundraising boards, special projects or fundraising volunteers. Indicate the nominee's willingness to play a public role or make presentations on behalf of organizations to raise charitable funds.
3. Describe the nominee's participation and support of other not for profit organizations locally, provincially, nationally or internationally. Evidence of this individual's inspired gifts and other meaningful support to a range of charitable organizations over a period of time. Emphasize overall commitment to charitable giving.
4. Highlight the impact and/or innovative approaches to philanthropy. Provide examples of creative fundraising ideas and implementation that the organization may not have used in the past. Identify innovative and entrepreneurial thinking that has developed a new revenue stream or created partnerships that did not exist in the past.

Other Requirements:

- Head shot/Logo for nominee.
- 3-5 one-page letters of support.

Confirmation of the following:

- I have informed the nominee they may be interviewed by the media and there is agreement to be interviewed at a convenient time and date.
- I have informed the nominee, if selected as the recipient they receive two complimentary tickets for themselves and a guest to attend the Manitoba Philanthropy Day Awards in November. Additional tickets can be purchased at the early bird or regular rate.
- I have informed the nominee they will be asked to participate in a video as part of the Manitoba Philanthropy Day Awards and they agreed to do so.
